



BEQUESTS

Bequests are a wonderful way to ensure that patient and family care continues to be provided to everyone who comes into the care of the Mary Potter Hospice or Calvary Cancer Services. After providing for your family and friends and once all debts and expenses are paid out, you may choose to leave a bequest to The Mary Potter Foundation in your will.

There are various forms of bequests you might consider including:

- the residue of your estate (after specific gifts and costs have been distributed)
- a percentage of the residue
- a specific amount of money
- specific items

Your solicitor can assist you with appropriate wording, however the following is sufficient to include The Mary Potter Foundation in your will:

"I bequeath unto The Mary Potter Foundation Inc the sum of \$..... for its general purposes, free from the payment of debts, funeral and testamentary expenses any duties payable in respect of my estate and declare that the receipt of the Secretary or other proper officer of The Mary Potter Foundation Inc shall be sufficient discharge to my Executors in respect thereof."

Including a bequest in your Will now has no impact on your lifestyle today and is the ultimate commitment to ensuring that patients and their families receive the care they need during illness and in bereavement.

If you decide to include a gift to the Mary Potter Foundation in your Will, please let us know. A surprise is wonderful, but we would like to appropriately acknowledge your contribution to supporting patient and family care.
